

MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Manuscripts should be submitted via the Editorial Manager (EM). It is very important that the manuscripts be submitted **to the USA EDITORIAL OFFICE of SHOCK.** This option will be provided at the beginning of the submission process via EM!

In addition, **all authors are requested to list their manuscript as “2016 MILITARY SUPPLEMENT” BEFORE the title of the manuscript when loading information on EM.** **When the authors are uploading the actual manuscript file, this information should also be listed in the Cover Letter that should accompany their manuscript.** This will alert and assure smooth and timely flow of the manuscript by the Editorial Office (Connie Weldon) through the review process and she will make sure all guidelines are followed and the figures are legible.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL AUTHORS must complete and digitally sign the “Copyright Transfer” form (5 page form, found on the EM under Files & Resources). **When all forms are complete, the corresponding author is responsible to load on Editorial Manager.** In order to save time all authors are encouraged to have them submitted on EM when they originally submit the manuscript! **Please be aware that the review process cannot be initiated until the signed copyright forms from all authors and co-authors are loaded. No scanned and/or faxed copyright forms are accepted.**

As you know, the SHOCK journal has specific instructions and guidelines for submitting articles. Please read and review them carefully. The Instructions for Authors guidelines, along with a copyright form are found on the website at: www.editorialmanager.com/shock

Authors are requested to pay close attention to format, style and quality of figures they may want to include into their manuscript. The quality of the figures should be checked each time the authors upload them on EM. Please see the above referenced link for more detailed information of the format, style and quality for submission. The references should not exceed 35 in number.
